APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP & FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called "Applicant") hereby applies for membership in and agrees to purchase electric energy from the SOUTHERN LEYTE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. (hereinafter called "Cooperative") upon the following terms and condition:

1. The applicant will, pay to the Cooperative the sum of P 5.00 which, if accepted by the Cooperative, will constitute the Applicant's membership fee.
2. The Applicant will when electric service becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all Electric Energy used on the premises described below and will pay therefore the monthly rates to be determined, from time to time in accordance with the by-laws of the Cooperative provided, however that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy to be furnished for industrial uses.
3. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specification approved by the Cooperative.
4. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the charter and by-laws of the Cooperative and such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative.
5. The Applicant by paying membership fee and becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debt or liability of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law his property is exempt from execution for any debt or liability.
6. The Applicant shall indemnify, save harmless and defend Cooperative against all liability, claims, judgements, cost and expenses for injury, loss or damage to persons or property on account of defective construction, wiring or appliances on Applicant's side of point of delivery.
7. The undersigned will grant to the Cooperative at its request the necessary rights and easements to construct, operate, replace, repair and perpetually maintain on the property owned by the undersigned and or upon all roads, streets, or highways abutting said property, its lines for transmission or distribution or electric energy and will execute and deliver to the Cooperative any conveyance, grant or instrument which the Cooperative and switches, meters and other appliances and equipment constructed and installed by the Cooperative on said property except so much thereof, if any, as shall be paid for by the undersigned, shall at all times be the sole property of the Cooperative and Cooperative shall have the rights of access to said property to operate maintain or relocate its facilities.
8. The Cooperative does not guarantee continues service but shall use reasonable diligence to provide uninterrupted service hereunder, and having used reasonable diligence, shall not be liable to the Applicant, for damage for failure in interruptions or suspensions of same. The Cooperative reserves the right to suspend services without liability on its part, such times for such periods and in such manner as may in its judgement be required for the purpose of making necessary repairs on the lines or other part of its systems.
9. The Cooperative is expressly authorized and empowered to remove its property and discontinue furnishing electric energy should Applicant fail to comply with any of the rules and regulations of the Cooperative, or become delinquent in an account due to the Cooperative for electric energy.
10. The Cooperative shall not be liable for damages caused by wiring or other accessories installed by the Applicant in his premises not in proper condition.
11. The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative and the contract for electric service shall continue in force from the date service is made available by the Cooperative to the Applicant, and as long as the Applicant has need for any electric service on the subject premises.
